For maximum flexibility, many travelers combine cards. For example, they may utilize a Chase Freedom card for everyday purchases, and then transfer points onto one of the Sapphire card in order to gain access to travel redemption options.

How Much Are Chase Ultimate Rewards Points Worth?

The worth of Chase points depends on how you can redeem them.

When using this Chase travel portal, your worth of your card is determined by the particular card.

Common values for redemption:

<i>Card</i>	<i>Value Per Point Through Chase Travel</i>
<i>Chase Sapphire Preferred</i>	<i>1.25 cents per point</i>
<i>Chase Sapphire Reserve</i>	<i>1.5 cents per point</i>
<i>Other Chase cards</i>	<i>Usually, it is 1 cent per point</i>

This is a reference to:

Example:

If you own at least 50,000 Chase points:

With Sapphire Preferred:

100,000 points x \$0.0125 is approximately \$625 as the value of travel

With Sapphire Reserve:

50k points multiplied by \$0.015 is approximately \$750 as travel value

The value may times be higher when transfer points to hotels or airlines partners.

How To Access The Chase Travel Portal

Making reservations through Chase is relatively straightforward.

Take these steps:

- ***Combining available options, if provided***

How To Book Flights Through Chase Ultimate Rewards Portal

Travel is one of the most popular ways that travelers utilize Chase points.

Example: Booking an International Flight With Chase Points

You're planning to book an air flight starting from New York to Paris.

The cash price:

\$900

Have you got a Chase Sapphire Preferred card.

The value of your redemption:

1 point = 1.25 cents

The points you need to earn:

\$900 / \$0.0125 is approximately 72,000 points

Instead of paying \$900 in cash to redeem it, you could use Chase points.

Before booking however your flight, consider comparing this possibility with the option of transfer points to a airline partner because you may occasionally get better value.

Should You Use Chase Travel Portal or Transfer Points?

Example:

10,000 Chase points equals 10,000 miles on a plane
